Background

Petro Mohyla Black Sea National University is the only University of classical type in the South of Ukraine, which combines western educational technologies with national traditions (Liberal Arts Education). The University proves its strong adherence to the internationalization activities by enhancing the cooperation with the partner universities and advancing the University's educational standards. The University maintains not only the international research activities on regular basis but also the foreign universities mobility programs among the students, staff and lecturers.

At a present stage, the university absorbed the experience of welcoming more than 200 lecturers from Australia, China, France, Germany, Japan, Italy, Lithuania, Norway, Poland, Romania, Russia, Southern Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, UK and USA. The University successfully completed many projects supported by the Embassies of France, Germany, Norway, Poland, Switzerland and USA. Among the others, there are summers schools, international scientific conferences and creation of European language centers.

During the last years, the University maintained productive long-term relations in the field of exchange programs related to Erasmus+ cooperation with such Partner Universities: University of Saarland (Germany), University of Cadiz (Spain), Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Italy) and Pomeranian Academy in Slupsk (Poland).
